• Horror Film Location Tour

Every year during the Halloween season, Dearly Departed offers a spooky tour of famous horror film locations hosted by a guide in full Michael Myers costume. Iconic film locations include: *Invasion of the Body Snatchers, A Nightmare on Elm Street, Michael Jackson's Thriller, Zombieland, Scream 2, Ed Wood, Drag Me to Hell,* and *Halloween –* both the John Carpenter and Rob Zombie versions. Guests will also visit two *Halloween* film locations where they will recreate iconic moments from the 1978 film, as well as visit the home where Dracula's Bela Lugosi died and receive a copy of his death certificate.

• The Karen CarpenTour

On February 4, 1983, beloved songbird Karen Carpenter became a star in heaven. To commemorate the anniversary of her passing, once a year, on Super Bowl Sunday, Dearly Departed offers a tour of Karen Carpenter locations across Southern California. Sites visited include the Carpenters' favorite L.A. haunts, the Downey home purchased for their parents where Karen collapsed the morning of her death, the locations of Carpenter's last meal, hospital visit, and funeral, and the Thousand Oaks cemetery where she now resides. A portion of each ticket for this tour goes to the National Eating Disorders Association.

• L.A. Rock 'N Roll Circus Tour
